From the VP President

Editor's Note: As the President, John Garfield, was unable to attend the January meeting, VP Brad led the meeting in his place and provides this summary instead of our usual message from the President.

First of all, I thanked David and Tina Silva for arranging the meeting and asked them to convey to the management and staff of Tachito's how much we appreciate their hospitality.

As a bit of background, in an effort to improve the yearly planning process the NTVT Board met in December to develop a schedule of events for 2017. The NTVT Board consists of the past president, current president, first and second Vice Presidents, the treasurer, and the secretary.

I presented that proposed schedule for 2017 to the members of the club at our meeting. The details of that proposed schedule are included in the secretary's minutes [see page 2]. The members present responded with suggestions for the June meeting, which the board will investigate. At the end of the meeting, Walter Martin volunteered to host the November cruise as he has land in the area and is familiar with the back roads. We are still in need of a host for the May 20th picnic in a park in Arlington or North Grand Prairie; Susan Zanella offered to help the host with that activity.

The NTVT board thought that a spring trip to the hill country would be appropriate since there is no VTCI South Central Regional Convention scheduled this year. I presented a draft itinerary for the NTVT Spring Hill Country Tour. Approximately ten people/couples indicated interest in the tour. By the time this newsletter arrives in your inbox, you should have received a draft itinerary with a link to the hotel so you can get your reservations in before the South Texas and Capitol City Thunderbirds are invited to join us.

The elections for 2017 officers are fast approaching (March). The 2nd VP (over membership) the only open position as the 1st VP will assume the presidency and the 2nd VP will move up to the 1st VP position. If you would like to serve or would like more information, please notify John Congleton, who is heading up the nominations committee.

January Meeting Minutes

The January 2017 meeting was held at Tachito's Mexican Restaurant, in Oak Cliff. There were 29 members in attendance.

After a great Mexican lunch, Brad Kershaw called the meeting to order at 11:30 am, and thanked members David and Tina Silva for hosting.

Secretary's Report. There were no December minutes, as we held our Christmas Party at Humperdincks in Arlington.

Treasurer's Report. Tom Ossorio reported that we are solidly "in the black."

Old Business. Brad reminded attendees to stay after the meeting and get their photos taken for Bonnie's Photo Roster, that will include photos of us and our beautiful automobiles. Other members should send aforementioned photos to Bonnie so that she can include them in the Roster, along with any name/address changes. He also mentioned that this was "Last Call" for 2017 VTCI Dues as Tom Ossorio, treasurer would submit those on Monday.

New Business. As usual, the primary business of the January meeting was to go over the proposed 2017 Calendar put together by the Board of Directors in mid-December:

February 18 Meeting: Spring Creek BBQ, in Bedford at Highway 183 and Forest Ridge.

April 7-9 Tour: To replace Regionals, it will encompass Burleson, Hamilton, Kerrville, Fredericksburg, and end in Waco; using the Y.O. Motel in Kerrville as home base, with room rate \$127/night (rooms in Fredericksburg were \$200.) The Tentative Itinerary has been published, with more information to follow. There is no April Meeting, due to Easter weekend and the following Leake Auction.

May 6: Sam Pack, Farmers Branch, and Cedar Creek Lake Car Shows. A preliminary vote shows a 50-50 participation in Sam Pack and Cedar Creek Lake.

May 20 Meeting: Picnic at an Arlington/North Grand Prairie Park (park TBD).

June 17 Meeting: A meeting at the Weatherford Vintage Car Museum was suggested. The museum has been expanded to include all the buildings all the way to the Square. Also, Streetside Classics was suggested for a follow-up meeting to last year's meeting there.

July 8 Meeting: At Dickey's, in Arlington, following the first day of the Yellow Rose All Ford Show (July 8-9).

August 19 Meeting: Matito's, in Lewisville.

September 13-17: VTCI Convention, Pine Mtn, GA.

September 16 Meeting: Wheels for Welness Car Show, in Fort Worth.

October 21 Meeting: Clark Gardens, Weatherford/Mineral Wells, with a catered lunch at the pavilion.

November 11 Meeting: Cruise to lunch and tour of Audie Murphy Museum, Greenville. Details to follow. WE NEED A HOST FOR THIS EVENT!

December 3: Christmas Party at Humperdincks, in Arlington, 4-6pm.


Brad adjourned the meeting after thanking the Staff at Tachito's.


